THE ANNUAL FESTIVAL

The annual Providence Children's Film Festival takes place in February at several venues within walking distance of downtown Providence, with eight full days of screenings (short and feature length films encompassing many genres, including live-action, animation and documentary), film-making workshops, and free activities, along with post-film conversations that help deepen the film-watching experience and foster critical thinking skills.

At the February 2015 festival, we will also present our 2nd annual Youth Filmmaker Show, which nurtures and promotes the work of young filmmakers from around the world.

PCFF presents films of the same high quality and film-related educational programming throughout the year. Now in our 6th year, PCFF has become more than just one of the top film festivals in the country dedicated to programming for children and youth.
