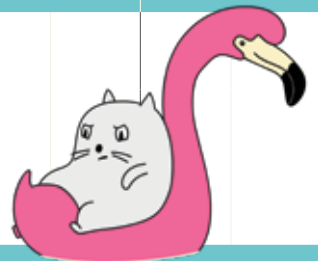

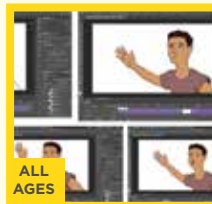
PITCH PERFECT: AN INSIDE LOOK AT SESAME STREET'S SHORT FILM COMMISSIONING PROCESS
